The Site

The Venue

The venue for the convention is JW Marriott The Rosseau Muskoka, located near the town of Minett. Guests enjoy luxurious surroundings and magnificent views overlooking Lake Rosseau.

The Gala

Children's Activity Program During Formal Event

This program will take place in the hotel from 6:30 pm to 11:00 pm. Children will be grouped by age to ensure age-appropriate activities. Older children are also welcome but activities are generally designed for 3-11 years of age. Parents of children in this age bracket will be contacted to determine if their children will be participating.

Registration Fees

The fee to attend the convention is \$1,095 per delegate, *which includes a spouse or companion who is not a work associate*. The fee for a delegate's dependent child 17 and over is \$465, and \$235 for any child aged 5 to 16 who attends any convention function. Children aged 4 and under may attend the convention functions at no charge, but they still must be registered. Registration forms must be received by UCA office by Friday, June 23, 2023. All registration fees must be paid by cheque or credit card by Friday, June 23, 2023. If payment is not received by that date, registration will be cancelled.
